The Royal Bengal Airline holds an exclusive seminar in Greater Manchester to announce the launch of its domestic and regional services.

The current directors of Royal Bengal Airline, the first UK based company to launch an international and domestic airline in Bangladesh, held an exclusive seminar on Monday 12th February 2007 at Millbrook Hall, the Menzies Avant Hotel, Windsor Road, Oldham for a personal introduction to Royal Bengal Airline's launch plans and investment opportunities.

Hundreds of guests attended the exclusive invitation only seminar where Royal Bengal Airline informed the audience that it has agreed to buy their first two domestic aircraft outright and are due to launch their domestic and regional services in Bangladesh within the next couple of months. The Managing Director, Shalim Rahman announced that the engineering team will shortly carry out the pre delivery inspection of the domestic aircrafts; the first two out from a fleet of ten.

Abdul Shukur Khalisadar, a director of the company described the venture as not only "Revolutionary, Bold & Ambitious" but also as "a gift from this generation to the previous and most importantly for generations to come".

Royal Bengal Airline also informed the Bengali community in the greater Manchester area of its long term objectives to develop a route from Manchester to Dhaka as well as its initial routes from London to Dhaka and Birmingham to Dhaka. Plans for the new Royal Bengal Airline London office were on display and the focused audience were told of the series of aircrafts that the company will be acquiring for operation.

Forhad Hussain, a member of the executive team of Royal Bengal Airline highlighted the "investor friendly model" that has been adopted by the company. He later went onto illustrate the professionalism of the team and in particular the UK lawyers, accountants & aviation consultants which the company has appointed.

The company also confirmed the issuance of a PATOL licence by the Bangladesh Civil Aviation authority, authorising domestic, regional and international cargo and passenger flights. The licence number is 105 and is registered under the Bangladesh company Aviana Airways Ltd trading as Royal Bengal Airline. Aviana Airways is owned 100% outright by the UK based company R B Airline UK Ltd.

Community leaders and local businessmen in the greater Manchester area extended their words of encouragement and appreciation for the venture. Monchab Ali JP, the Chair of Greater Sylhet Council UK, welcomed the Royal Bengal Airline management team and praised the pioneers, he also stated "I am delighted to learn that third generation Bangladeshis are working on this project, but what is further encouraging is to see the professionalism and high levels of standards that is being demonstrated by our children"
